

## School Meal Prices

For elementary school students, lunch costs \$2.25. For middle and high school students, lunch costs \$2.35. Breakfast is also available at schools, and it costs \$1.75 for elementary school students and \$1.85 for middle and high school students. À la carte milk is 35 cents. Schools offer free and reduced prices for breakfast and lunch to students who qualify based on USDA guidelines.\* Many schools offer an à la carte program. JCPS School and Community Nutrition Services will notify parents/guardians about meal prices and payment options, including prepayment, by U.S. Mail.
