The Jefferson County Public School (JCPS) district is participating in the federally funded USDA Summer Food Service Program for children 18 years of age and younger. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability. There will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

The following sites will be "closed enrolled" sites providing meal service only to "enrolled" children in attendance at the school sites. A "closed enrolled site" is determined by income guidelines for free/reduced price meals in the National School Lunch Program based on its enrollment roster. Meal service will be provided at the sites and times as listed.
